Virtual Committee Meeting Minutes from July 2024

Reason for the Virtual Meeting

- Committee members were unavailable during May consequently these July minutes were accumulated from Emails, the Committee chat group and discussions between Committee Members.

Committee Status

- We remain open to additions to the current Committee.

Membership

- Full Membership;- We currently have 33 full members in a season where we lost several members but recovered with 7 new Full Members. Early season match turnout has been good.
- Associate Membership;- Currently we have 5 Associate Members all paying by Bank Transfer, we await the Bank Statement.

Financial Statement July 2024

- A couple of seasons ago we agreed and adopted an accounting format where club prize money was derived from Full member subscriptions after deducting fixed costs therefore balancing with variable costs being deducted from Fladbury Income ie, Associate subscriptions & Club Bookings. This format was developed to ensure correct distribution of funding.
- The July Financial status shows that we have overspent Fladbury Income mainly due to reduced revenue from Associate membership & contractor costs incurred to remove a large tree in peg 24 following the floods. We have also had Fladbury access cleared twice. The financial situation will be clearer following the September meeting where we will have fully received Associate subscriptions and revenue from club bookings.

Match Series Payout

- £50 has been paid to the first 3 in the 5 match Winter Pools Series.
- £50 awaits the first 3 in the 5 match Spring League Series.
- £100 awaits the first 3 in the 10 match Aggregate Series.

AGM decision affecting the Venue List in 2025

- Just a reminder that following the regular cancellation of the January match on pools the AGM decided in future to drop the January match, the 2025 season will now start in February.

Fishery Status

- The top of the pegs were cleared in May and again in July. All of the 26 match pegs and 9 lock stream pegs have been cleared, pegs 27 & 28 need new platforms. Next Bank Clearing is 11/8/2024.
- In the early matches Bream have responded to the GB feeder with Red Maggot, at the moment the river is low & clear.
